Alabama Jail Training Academy Online Registration Instructions

- Go to www.alabamacounties.org
- Click on Events on the top left hand side of the page. Choose the month of AJTA Class you want to attend on the calendar and click on class name. To the right side of the map, click on the red tab that says **Register for this Event**. (This will open a separate window.)
- Click on **Register for this Event** and it will ask you to enter your primary email address. You must be logged in to register for an event.
- If you have never used our system, you will need to create an account. Click on **New Visitor Registration** to create an account. Enter your email address and click **Go**. Enter your contact information and hit **Create Account**. From there, continue registering by clicking **Next**.
