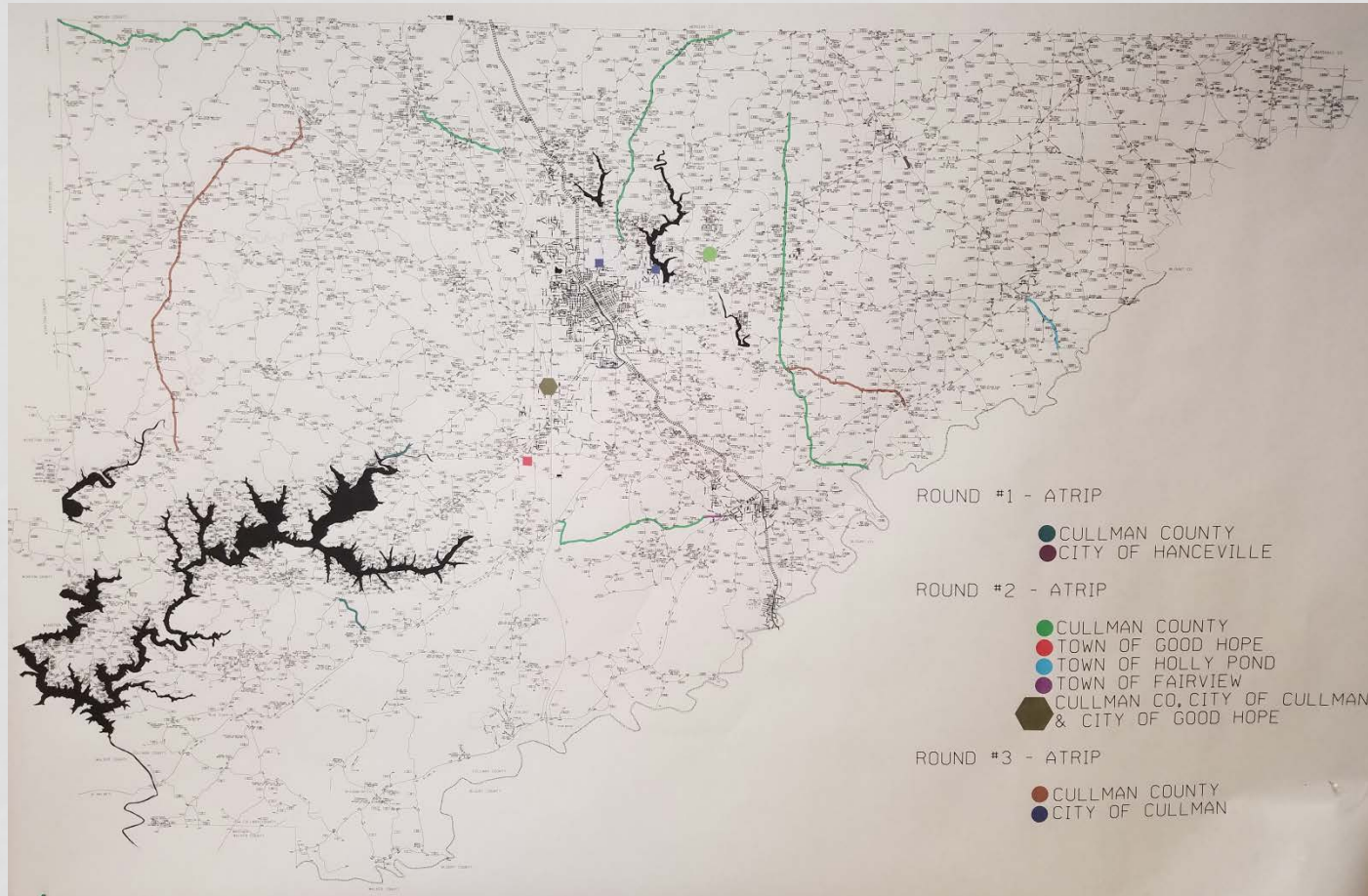
CULLMAN COUNTY

- Population ~82,000
- Strong economy, steady growth, low unemployment
- LARGE Road Network
 - 2,393 total miles (State, Municipal, County)
 - 1,563 total county maintained road miles
 - 1,334 paved; 229 gravel
- Statewide problem is more acute due to population, road volume, fuel tax distribution.

ROAD DEPARTMENT BUDGET

- \$8.1 Million for FY 2018
- Effectively flat for ~16 years
- Fuel Tax revenue \$2.5-2.7 million for 16 years

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- Major Collectors
 - 17 Year Federal Aid equivalent
 - 28 Million dollar cumulative ATRIP total
 - 33.8 Million dollar total project cost
- 62 Miles of Resurfacing
- Partnership with City of Cullman and ALDOT for Interstate Interchange
 - Exit 305 at County Road 222
 - 21 Million dollar project

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
