### NATURE OF WORK

Within the general parameters established by the County Commission and under their administrative direction, the employee serves as the County's Engineer and Director of the department. The County Engineer performs highly responsible and diversified professional engineering work, providing oversight, management and supervision for all department personnel and engineering operations. Responsibilities range from establishing departmental goals and priorities in conjunction with the Commission, to planning and implementing engineering projects, managing the departmental budget and personnel matters, and ensuring that all projects and functions fall within established parameters and mandates. The employee advises on priorities, materials, equipment and/or projects to be undertaken by County Commissioners. The County Engineer administers and manages projects involving state or federal funds. The employee also administers the County's flood insurance program. Considerable independent judgment and latitude are afforded this employee in the operation of the department and associated projects.
