SCOPE: This position performs technical duties in the fabrication, installation, maintenance and repair of traffic control devices.

REQUIRED HOURS OF AVAILABILITY: Monday – Thursday; 6:00 am – 4:30 pm; on call

#### EXAMPLE OF DUTIES PERFORMED:

- Travels scheduled routes throughout the County jurisdiction inspecting signs and lights.
- Repairs and replaces electric traffic lights.
- Fabricates and installs traffic signs.
- Cleans, paints and repairs traffic signs.
- Assists with paving and resurfacing of roadways.
- Maintains external lights at Court House and other county facilities.

#### SUMMARY OF QUALIFICATIONS:

- Possession of a valid Commercial, Class A or B, driver's license issued by the State of Alabama.
- Knowledge of traffic hazards, safety principles, rules, regulations and speed limits.
- Knowledge of electric lights and electric traffic signals.
- Knowledge and level of competency commonly associated with completion of specialized training in the field of work, in addition to basic skills typically associated with a high school education.
- Sufficient vision or other powers of observation, with or without reasonable accommodation, which permits the employee to observe road conditions.
- Sufficient manual dexterity with or without reasonable accommodation, which permits the employee to operate a motor vehicle and perform maintenance tasks.
