## Position Announcement #ENG8-18-27 Traffic Control Technician Closing Date: September 10, 2018

DEPARTMENT: Highway

STATUS: Full-Time

PAY GRADE: 13      STARTING ANNUAL SALARY RANGE: \$34,632.00-\$36,795.20

SCOPE: This position performs technical duties in the fabrication, installation, maintenance and repair of traffic control devices.

REQUIRED HOURS OF AVAILABILITY: Monday – Thursday; 6:00 am – 4:30 pm; on call

### EXAMPLE OF DUTIES PERFORMED:

- Inspects, repairs and replaces traffic signals.
- Cleans, paints, repairs, fabricates and installs traffic signs.
- Ensures County compliance with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD).
- Places necessary signage for road closures in accordance with the MUTCD.
- Operates a bucket truck.
- Responds to emergencies regarding roadway signage and traffic signals.
- Assists with paving and resurfacing of roadways.
- Operates a chain saw and/or gasoline powered hedge clippers to cut or trim vegetation restricting vehicle operator visibility.
- Maintains awareness of and reports issues of potential concern to the Highway Department and/or the Alabama Department of Transportation.

### SUMMARY OF QUALIFICATIONS:

- Knowledge and level of competency commonly associated with completion of specialized training in the field of work, in addition to basic skills typically associated with a high school education.
- Sufficient experience to understand the basic principles relevant to the major duties of the position, usually associated with the completion of an apprenticeship/internship or having had a similar position for one to two years.
- Possession of a valid driver's license issued by the State of Alabama.
- Availability for on-call status at designated times.

\*The principal duties of this position are performed in an outside work environment with potential personal hazards.
