

As a Regular Member you are entitled to vote on matters such as the election of CROAA officers and directors, the ratification of annual dues, and any amendments to the Association's by-laws.

Associate Members shall enjoy all rights and privileges of regular members but may not hold office or vote on Association matters.






an affiliate organization of the Association of County Commissions of Alabama (ACCA). CROAA annual meetings and various other meetings are generally held as part of an ACCA event.
