One of the most important elements of the ACCA Annual Convention is the election of the Association's Officers and Board of Directors. The Board of Directors includes a member representative from each district in the state who will serve a one-year term.

Candidates should not seek these offices unless they are willing to make a commitment to be an active and regular participant in Association activities and endeavors. Officers are called upon throughout the year to represent the Association at various events, and it is important that all officers are available to travel to Montgomery when needed. Candidates must also be in compliance with the provisions of Alabama law regarding the mandatory training program for newly-elected county commissioners.

ACCA staff will publish a listing of all district candidates for the Board both before and during the Convention. An official ballot will be prepared for each county. Only those who return the form before the deadline will be listed on the ballot.
