Applications are accepted through the <u>Mobile County Personnel Board</u> utilizing an online application process. Visit the Mobile County Personnel Board website at <u>www.personnelboard.org</u> and select the Employment tab to view the list of job postings. On the job posting for County Administrator, select the "Apply" link to create a JobOpps account and apply for the position. Applications, once submitted, are final; therefore, all documentation to be considered (college transcripts, certifications, licenses, etc.) must be attached to the application at the time of submission. <u>College Transcript Information</u> may be found on the left side of the Job Opportunities page.

#### <u>Benefits</u>
