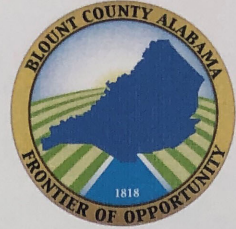

WHEREAS, the Blount County Commission has joined the State and Federal Government in declaring an emergency due to the COVID-19 Coronavirus epidemic; and




WHEREAS, it is anticipated that additional orders and recommendations from the State and Federal level will make it increasingly difficult to maintain routine operations;




- The Blount County Hope House

- Blount County Department of Human Resources


