This certificate of compliance is being submitted as required by the Rebuild Alabama Act to verify a minimum of 50% of the County Rebuild Alabama Funds (CRAFs) for the fiscal year 2020 were expended utilizing a contract. The counties actual expenditures under a contract were 0%.

Escambia County was directly impacted by two natural disasters this year, Hurricane Sally in September and Hurricane Zeta in October. Therefore, Escambia County's plans were changed and we were unable to use our forces to work on our Rebuild Alabama Projects but were forced to concentrate our efforts to clear debris from our roadways and to repair our roadways from the storm damage. Therefore, Escambia County's planned projects for fiscal year 2020 will be completed in the spring of 2021 when we have recovered from the damages caused by Hurricane Sally and Hurricane Zeta.
