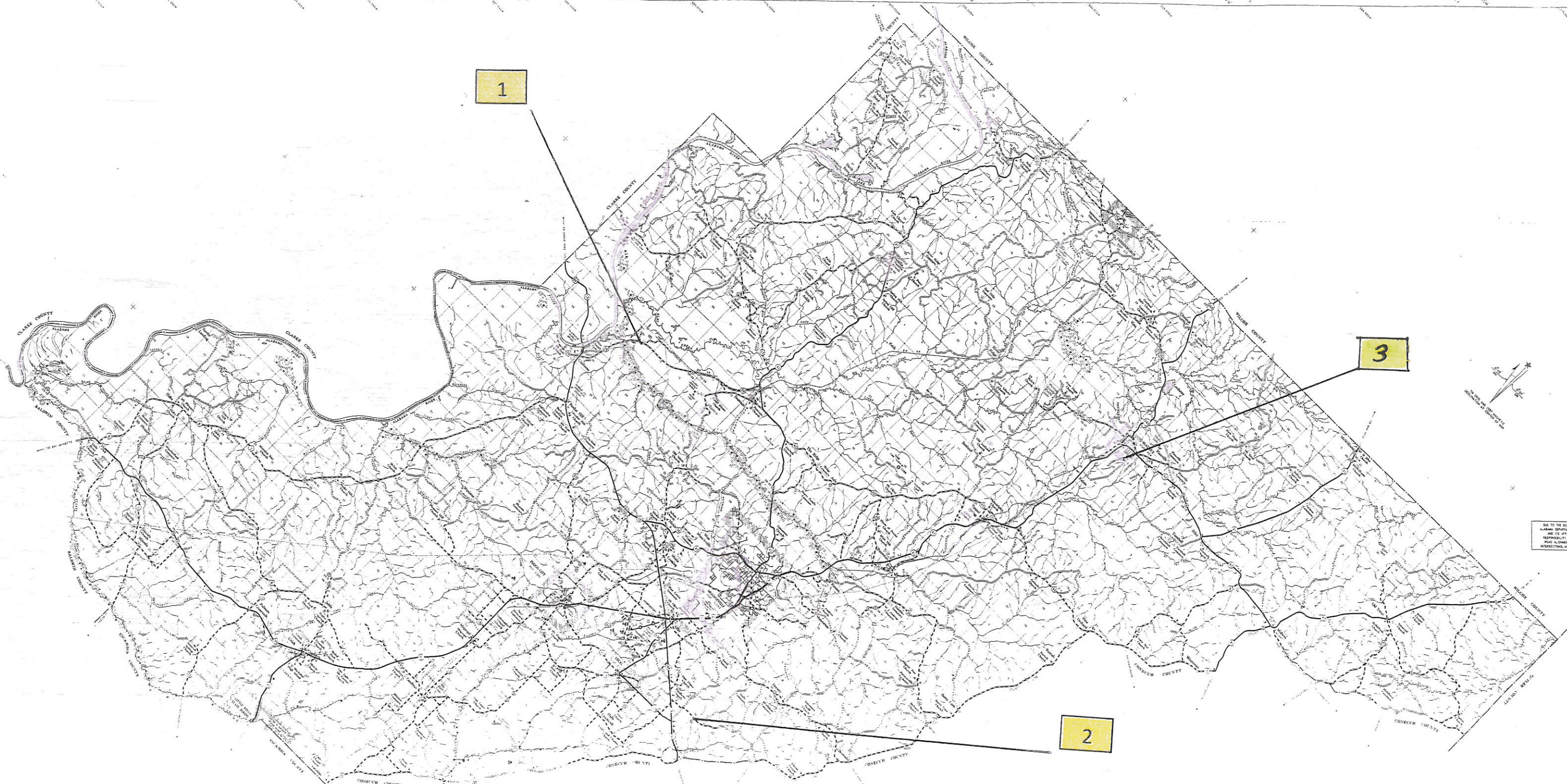
Note: Any amendments to the CTP shall follow the same guidelines and procedures as the original approval process.

Remarks We borrowed \$1.4 Million and used \$391,000 of severed materials funds with \$90,560 of CRAF funds for our 2020 resurfacing project. We will pay \$456,000 in loan payments thru 8/2021. We expect to use the remaining CRAF funds for Project No. MCP 50-13-20 with the possibility of adding additional projects depended on the amount of funds received. Project No. MCP 50-10-18 came in well under the estimate amount. We anticipate having the majority of 2020 funds remaining from the project and expect to add a project or roll the money into next year.
