NOTES

1. In-place volume prior to excavation. Estimated as 13,250 CY reusable, and 2,500 CY to be hauled off.
2. In-place volume following installation, not accounting for potential shrinkage.
3. Base course 26 feet wide.
Wearing surface layer 22 feet wide.
Binder leveling layer 23 feet wide.
Required shoulder, 5 feet wide each side, using Aggregate Surfacing.
4. Pipe is Aluminized Steel Type 2, 60 inch diameter, 12 gauge.
Paved invert NOT required.
The seepage collars are a subsidiary obligation of this pay item.
5. See Note 3 on Page R102.
6. Pipe for guardrail posts. Backfilling after post insertion with ALDOT 825 stone is a subsidiary obligation of this pay item.
7. ALDOT #57 Stone.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS:

- (1) The contractor shall fill in all required blanks on the bid pricing form included herein.
- (2) A bid bond in the amount of 5% of the total bid cost shall be included with each bid submitted, but not to exceed \$10,000.00.
- (3) A performance bond and payment bond each in the amount of 100% of the total bid price will be required within fifteen (15) calendar days of the notice of award.
- (4) Contractor shall submit with bid a copy of a certificate of insurance (\$1.0 million minimum) and workman's compensation.
- (5) The successful bidder shall begin work at least 15 calendar days after date of notice to proceed.
- (6) Work is to be completed within 60 working days after begin work date. It is the bidder's responsibility to familiarize himself with and shall comply with all requirements and specifications as stated in the *Alabama Department of Transportation - Standard Specifications for Highway Construction-2022 Edition*. The definition for "State" as listed in the before mentioned manual, in Section 101.01, shall be changed to read as follows: "*Marshall County, a political subdivision of the State of Alabama, the party of the first part to the contract acting by and through the Marshall County Commission*".
- (7) The Contractor shall include in his/her bid price the cost for all materials, labor, equipment, and incidentals necessary for the work to be completed in-place.
- (8) Payment will be made on a monthly basis for work completed. There will be retained five (5) percent of the amount of the work done and will be held until completion of all work and final acceptance by the Marshall County Commission. No further retainage will be held after 50 percent of work completed.

Upon completion of all work, the contractor must give notice of completion of the project by advertising in a local newspaper.

Advertisement must run for a period of four (4) consecutive weeks and provide the County with proof of advertising (affidavit) from the paper, and a release of lien.

Upon completion and acceptance of all work, final payment will be made.

- (9) The Contractor shall indemnify and save harmless Marshall County, Marshall County Commission, the officers and employees from all suits, actions, or claims of any character brought because of any injuries or damages received by any person, persons, or property on account of the said Contractor, or through use of unacceptable materials in constructing the work; or because of any claims or amounts arising or recovered under the "Workman's Compensation Act" or any other law, ordinance, order or decree.
- (10) It shall be the bidder's responsibility to possess all proper City, County, State, and Federal licenses and shall familiarize himself with and shall comply with all Federal, State, and local laws, ordinances, and regulations.

(11) By signing this contract, the contracting parties affirm, for the duration of the agreement that they will not violate federal immigration law or knowingly employ, hire for employment, or continue to employ an unauthorized alien within the State of Alabama. Furthermore, a contracting party found to be in violation of this provision shall be deemed in breach of the agreement and shall be responsible for all damages resulting therefrom.

Each bidder is required to submit with the bid a certificate of E-Verify.

(12) Bids may be submitted either by mail or in person, however, Marshall County will not be responsible for the security of mailed bids. (Also, if mailing bid, please be advised that we do not receive mail before 10:00 A.M. daily, therefore mail early to ensure prompt arrival).

(13) By signing and submitting of this bid, the vendor certifies that he/she is an equal opportunity employer.

(14) Bidders are required to use this "Invitation For Bids". Bidders shall bid all items, sign, and return all sheets in the "Invitation For Bids" to *Marshall County Engineering, 424 Blount Ave., Suite 305, Guntersville, AL 35976*. Failure to do so will be cause for rejection of bid.

(15) Each individual bid must be submitted in a sealed envelope with the word "BID" and name of item marked on outside of envelope, along with the contractor's license number. **Bids need to be mailed to Marshall County Engineering Department, 424 Blount Ave., Suite 305, Guntersville, AL 35976**

You are invited to bid on the above specifications. Any substitutes offered, other than the items specified, must include information showing that the substitute is of equal or better quality and equally or better suited for the purported use than the item specified. The right to reject any items or materials not of quality or under any provisions of this act is reserved.

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed Proposals (Bids) for the construction of “Union Grove Road Reconstruction over Tacket Branch”, will be received by the Marshall County Commission (Owner) in the Marshall County Commission Chamber – 3rd Floor, Room #A319 – 424 Blount Avenue – Guntersville, AL 35976 until 8:30 A.M., Central Standard Time on Wednesday, May 25, 2022, at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read aloud.

Plans and specifications are available from the Marshall County Engineering Department – 3rd Floor, Room #A337 – 424 Blount Avenue – Guntersville, AL 35976 (256-571-7712), or online at www.marshallco.org.

Bids must be submitted on proposal forms furnished by the Owner. All bidders must show evidence of license before bidding or bid will not be received or considered by the owner. The bidder shall show such evidence by clearly displaying his or her current license number on the outside of the envelope in which the proposal is delivered. The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all proposals and to waive technical errors if, in the Owner’s judgment, the best interests of the Owner will thereby be promoted. No bid may be withdrawn after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids for a period of thirty (30) days.

Each bidder is required to submit with the bid a certificate of E-Verify.

A certified check or bank draft, payable to Marshall County Commission, or a satisfactory bid bond executed by the bidder and acceptable sureties in an amount equal to five (5) percent of the bid, but not to exceed \$10,000, shall be submitted with each bid.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish and pay for satisfactory performance and payment bonds, each in the amount of 100 percent of the contract price.


Contractor shall be licensed in accordance with Alabama State Laws. Proof of licensure will be required on the outside of the Bid Envelope before bid will be considered. Subcontractors whose contracts exceed \$50,000.00 must also be licensed according to the State of Alabama Law and show proof thereof.

The Owner is a tax free organization. With this project, contractor is to bid the project without taxes on materials. The successful bidder will be given forms to purchase materials tax free for this project.

Bid may be held by the County for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days from the date of opening of bids for the purpose of reviewing them and investigating the qualifications of the bidders, prior to awarding the contract. Any successful bidder who withdraws their bid for any reason within the 30 day period may forfeit the bid bond.

The Marshall County Commission reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informalities in the bidding.
