Bids will be accepted based on the price index per gallon of asphalt as determined by the Alabama Department of Transportation for the month of December 2022. Any increase or decrease in asphalt prices will be determined by the price index for the month of purchase.

### RESPONSIBILITY FOR DAMAGE CLAIMS

The contractor shall indemnify and save harmless Walker County, Walker County Commission, the officers and employees from all suits, actions or claims of any character brought because of any injuries or damages received or sustained by any person, persons, or property on account of the operations of said Contractor; or through use of unacceptable materials in constructing the work; because of any act of omission, neglect, or misconduct of said Contractor; or because of any claims or amounts arising or recovered under the Workmen's Compensation Act or decree.

Pursuant to Alabama Code 31-13-9, as a condition of the award of any contract, the business entity or employer, and any of its subcontractors, shall provide documentation that it is enrolled in the E-Verify Program. By signing this contract, the contracting parties affirm, for the duration of the agreement, that they will not violate federal immigration law or knowingly employ, hire for employment, or continue to employ an unauthorized alien within the state of Alabama. Furthermore, a contracting party found to be in violation of this provision shall be deemed in breach of the agreement and shall be responsible for all damages resulting therefrom.

This bid will be for the period of February 1, 2023 to December 31, 2023.

The bid award may be renewed for up to a period of two (2) additional years upon agreement of both parties.

The Walker County Commission will reserve the right to reject any and all bids.
