



## Court-Ordered Community Service Insurance



This Accidental Death & Dismemberment (AD&D) policy provides coverage to a government entity for individuals who are given a court-ordered community service sentence. The insured entity will receive a lump-sum payment if the inmate is killed in a covered accident. Optional enhancements include a medical expense benefit that can assist the entity with charges resulting from a covered accident.
