The Purchasing Agent of Escambia County, Alabama, is requesting sealed bids for the purchase of concrete pipe.

**INVITATION TO BID
Concrete Pipe**

Sealed bids for concrete pipe for a period of five (5) months, effective May 1, 2024, will be received by the Escambia County Commission at the Courthouse, 314 Belleville Avenue, Brewton, Alabama until 10:00 a.m., Wednesday, April 17, 2024.

All bids must be signed and sealed with the subject matter marked plainly on the outside of the envelope.

Concrete pipe shall conform to the current ALDOT Standard Specifications for Highway Construction and bidder shall furnish test reports certifying that the material meets ALDOT specs if requested.

Bids must specify price per linear foot and include delivery to job sites within Escambia County. Any exceptions must be clearly stated by the Vendor in a separate attachment.

All bidders must use the attached Bid Submission Form and each bid shall be filled out in ink. Bid prices are to cover a five (5) month period effective May 1, 2024.

The contract shall cover the County's needs from May 1, 2024 through September 30, 2024 with an option to issue a second and third six (6) month contract under the same pricing, terms, and conditions. The second and third contract, if requested by the County and agreed upon by the vendor, would begin the day after the first or second contract expires. Any successive contract must have written approval of both the County and the vendor no later than seven (7) days prior to the expiration of the previous contract.

All bidders shall be licensed in the State of Alabama.

E-VERIFY REQUIREMENT: In accordance with the Code of Alabama, 1975 as amended, §31-13-9, the successful bidder, “shall not knowingly employ, hire for employment, or continue to employ an unauthorized alien within the State of Alabama and shall attest to such, by sworn affidavit signed before a notary.” Additionally, the business entity “shall provide documentation establishing that [it] is enrolled in the E-Verify program” and that during the contract period, it “shall participate in the E-Verify program and shall verify every employee that is required to be verified according to the applicable federal rules and regulations.” This section shall also apply to subcontractors. The successful bidder shall provide proof of enrollment in the E-Verify program **before** receiving a contract.

All bids should be sealed with subject matter marked plainly on outside of envelope. They should be addressed to Raymond Wiggins, Purchasing Agent, and P.O. Box 848, Brewton, Alabama 36427 and delivered to him or mailed in time to reach him on or before 10:00 A.M. on Wednesday, April 17, 2024. All bids will be opened and considered at this time by the Purchasing Agent in the County Commission Chamber Room in the Escambia County Courthouse in Brewton, Alabama.
