This contract shall be in effect for five (5) months from May 1, 2024 through September 30, 2024 with an option to extend an additional twelve (12) months if requested by Escambia County, and agreed upon by vendor. The second, 12-month contract, would begin October 1, 2024 and end September 30, 2025.

The Contractor, at its sole expense, shall obtain and maintain in full force the following insurance to protect the Contractor and the County Commission of Escambia County, Alabama (CCEC) at limits and coverages specified below. These limits and coverages specified are the minimum to be maintained and are not intended to represent the correct insurance needed to fully and adequately protect the Contractor.

All insurance will be provided by insurers licensed to conduct business in the State of Alabama and shall have a minimum A.M. Best rating of A- VII and must be acceptable to the CCEC. Self-insured plans and/or group funds not having an A.M. Best rating must be submitted to the CCEC for prior approval.

No work shall be performed until proof of compliance with the insurance requirements has been received by the CCEC.

Worker's Compensation and Employers Liability

- 1. Statutory Benefits as required by the State of Alabama

The ISO Form CG 20 10 11 85 or a comparable form that is no more restrictive shall be required. The Additional Insured form MUST include the current Operations and Products/Completed Operations of the contractor. The naming of the additional insured does not obligate the additional insured to pay any premiums due.

Aggregate limits to be on a "per project" basis OR an Owners and Contractors Protective Liability Policy shall be provided in the name of CCEC, the contractor and Subcontractors. Limits to be the same as above Commercial General Liability.

Automobile Liability
