**ALABAMA VICTIM NOTIFICATION STATUTORY  
REQUIREMENTS AS OF JULY 1, 2025**

Consistent with Alabama law, the above-referenced notifications shall be made in the manner and timeframe prescribed above upon request of the victim. The victim is defined by Code of Alabama (1975) § 15-23-60 as "[a] person against whom the criminal offense has been committed, or if the person is killed or incapacitated, the spouse, sibling, parent, child, or guardian of the person, except if the person is in custody for an offense or is the accused."

With the exception of accused persons or detainees designated as Youthful Offender, a participating county may, but is not required to, allow for additional notifications to be made consistent with the RFP. In the event the accused or detainee is designated as a Youthful Offender, notification shall ONLY be made to the victim as defined by the statute above.
