## 1. Major Duties:

#### I. ENGINEER

- a. Employ, supervise and direct such assistants as are necessary to construct and maintain properly the county public roads, highways, and bridges;
- b. Perform such engineering and surveying services as may be required to prepare and maintain the necessary maps, plans, and records;
- c. Maintain the necessary accounting records to reflect the cost of constructing and maintaining the county highway system
- d. Perform such other duties as are necessary and incident to the operation of the county highway system as directed by the county commission
- e. Maintain a Certified Bridge Inspector License.
- f. Coordinate with EMA Director and County Commissioners during emergency situations.
- g. Maintain a relationship with the Alabama Department of Transportation.
- h. Pursue all funding opportunities with the Alabama Department of Transportation and related agencies.
- i. Maintain herbicide license
- j. Works storm/disaster events from warning stage though completion in coordination with local departments and state EMA

### II. Marion County – Rankin Fite Airport

- a. Marion County's Point of Contact with the Alabama Department of Transportation and the Federal Aviation Administration.
- b. Oversee operations at the Marion County-Rankin Fite Airport

## III. Marion County Solid Waste

a. Oversee Operations with the Marion County Solid Waste

Must be highly motivated with computer skills and written and oral communications skills. Work involves supervision of staff, coordinating various programs and grant administration.

Applicant must have knowledge of state, federal and county standards, regulations; knowledge of the principals and practices of administration, community organizations and operations; ability to effectively handle potentially dangerous situations in an emergency and the ability to exercise judgement.
